

Application Documents and Requirements

- **A Completed Online Application Form**
- **Copy of Passport or ID Card**
- **Official Academic Transcripts***
- **Proof of English Language Proficiency****

**All documents that are not in English must be accompanied by an official English translation.*

** English Language Requirements

CEFR Level: B2+/C1/C2 or IELTS 6.0 (no band less than 5.5) or equivalent in TOEFL (iBT), Duolingo, Pearson, Cambridge.

Swedish High School English: Avgångsbetyg / Slutbetyg från Gymnasieskola (Upper secondary school leaving certificate) - Level 6 with at least Grade E.

All English language tests / results expire after two years for admissions & entry purposes.
